

California Science Test (CAST)


- Administered in the Spring grades 5, 8, and once in high school

- Available in multiple languages













2023-24 SBA Math, % Met/Exceeded - AUSD, County, State




Math - Latina/o/e Students






ELA 2023-24 SBA, Latina/o/e Students Alameda County Districts

ELA SBA - Latina/o Students










English Learner (EL) or Multilingual Learner (MLL)

- EL students are assessed yearly using the Summative ELPAC until they are reclassified as English proficient based on 4 criteria:
 - 1. Assessment of English Language Proficiency
 - 2. Teacher Evaluations
 - Parent Consultation
 - 4. Basic Skills Relative to English Proficient Students
- Research suggests that it typically takes 4 to 7 years to develop full proficiency in another language




ELA Elementary 3th-5th - Latina/o/e




ELA - Latina/o/e Students




ELA Elementary 3th-5th - Race/Ethnicity




ELA - Race/Ethnicity 3-5




ELA Elementary 3th-5th - Other Subgroups




ELA - Subgroups 3-5




Math Elementary 3th-5th - Race/Ethnicity











Analysis

Successes

- Latina/o students in Albany outperform Latina/o/e students in both the county and the state on SBA FLA and Math
 - ELA 3rd highest of all schools in Alameda County
 - Math 4th highest of all schools in Alameda County
- Healthy Kids Survey, Academic motivation: 5th grade Latina/o/e students report "strongly agree" 5 percent more than the average for all 5th grade

Challenges

- We continue to see significant achievement gap in SBA, ELA and Math scores for Latina/o/e students as compared to the average
- ELA scores for Latina/o/e students, 3rd-5th, have fallen by an average of 5 points each year since the pandemic
